Last year we opened a VIP Area to the event, where attendees who purchased the upgraded ticket were allowed entry to taste and vote in the homebrew contest. This was such a popular part of the event, we’re doing it again this year! Attendees of past events continuously tell us how much they enjoy the home brewers. What would be a better way to highlight talented home brewers than featuring them as the VIP section? We need your help to make it successful!

As this is a non-sanctioned event, **you do not submit beer ahead of the event.** We ask that you bring enough beer for approximately 350 small samples (about a case of beer) and to pour your samples from 4-6 p.m. We will have a number of volunteers on hand to give you breaks to go enjoy the event. VIP ticket holders enjoy talking with and learning from the home brewers so be prepared to show off your knowledge about zymurgy! The home brewers contest will be judged by popular vote and there will be three winners. Brewers may submit their choice of beer style, and it can be kegged or bottled.
